3 P's of Grants

- Path
 - What is the problem and solution
- Place
 - Where will it help
- People
 - Who is on your team



PATH

- Problem
 - Define the need or opportunity
- Solution
 - Present the best solution and back it up with data
- Results
 - Give specific but obtainable outputs and outcomes
 - Make sure narrative and budget match



PLACE

Location

- Know the funders boundaries
- Demonstrate clear understanding of need and impact
- Definition
 - Clearly define the site/location specifics (avoid Bigger is Better mindset)
 - Unique solution
- Impact
 - Exact scope and size of project
 - Maximize impact for the investment



PEOPLE

- Beneficiaries
 - How will project benefit people in area?
 - Strong local support, multiple stakeholders
- Winning Team
 - Demonstrate accountability
 - Share past success stories
- Partners
 - Show you have the right people with right qualifications- or a plan to get them!
